Utility Rates Increasing

The Tangent City Council in conjunction with the Tangent Budget Committee has increased utility rates beginning July 1st by 2.1% which was the Consumer Price Index increase as of February 2021. This translates into an increase of \$1.25; one dollar is for the Sewer Fee and the 25 cents is for the Parks Fee. You will see this reflected on your utility bill sent at the end of July for July service.

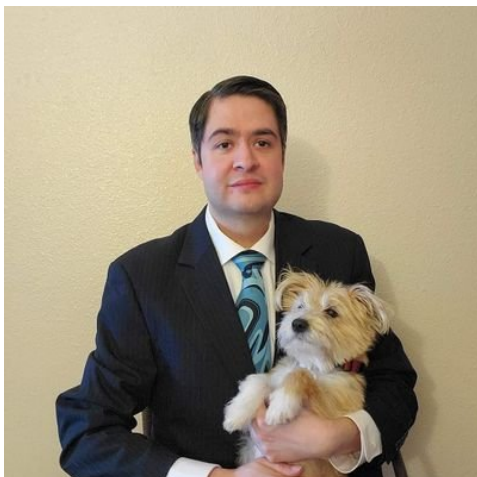
Do You Have Outdated or Unused Medication?

The City of Tangent is supporting the MED-Project. We have the MED-Project old prescription bags here in City Hall. Anyone can come in, take a bag, and mail off unused or expired prescription medications. The mailbags are already stamped with postage, so no costs to you, and they will be safely disposed of at the receiving site.

Chlorine Shortage

The City of Tangent is aware of the situation with the potential chlorine supply disruption. We have informed all City Council members and the Mayor of the situation, but we will not be immediately impacted. Every resident and business in Tangent operates on well water, and our STEP septic system does not use chlorine during the summer months. We do not have any chlorine stored currently and we will not be ordering any until November.
