COVID Procedures

The City of Tangent will follow this procedure during the pandemic caused by the COVID-19 (Coronavirus) and the following variants. State and federal mandates may supersede these policies.

<p>Five-day average of 1,000 cases a day or more. When the State of Oregon has a five day average of 1,000 cases or more a day, the city will enact the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Mandatory masks at City Hall• Social distancing• City Hall closed except for utility payments• Virtual meetings only
<p>Five-day average of 800 cases a day up to 999. When the State of Oregon has a five day average of 800 or more cases, but not exceeding 999 cases:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• City staff wear a mask when interacting with the public• Social Distancing• Reduce Capacity for meetings at City Hall• Meetings will have masks optional
<p>Five-day average of 600 cases a day up to 799.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Social Distancing• Virtual meeting encouraged• Mask optional
<p>Five-day average below 600 cases a day.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Normal operations

From July 1-15, the State of Oregon was averaging less than 600 cases a day, and it wasn't until we passed 600 cases a day average discussions began to pick up about wearing masks and social distancing.

The week of July 26-30 is when we average 993 cases a week, and CDC/OHA made the new recommendation.

Today (8/5/21), we are averaging 1033 cases a day; we went to red today.

Following this model, we'll provide more clarity on what is going on in City Hall. It will take time for the average to drop or increase to another level, reducing the confusion of what level we're at, and below is the link to the State of Oregon, Oregon Health Authority's daily numbers of cases.
