Tangent Drive Update

Linn County, in cooperation with the City of Tangent, is in the planning stage for a street and pedestrian improvement project on Tangent Drive. The project will start at Highway 99E and end at Meadow Wood Street. The preliminary plans for improvements include a new road surface with the addition of bike lanes, a sidewalk on at least one side of the road, and the planting of street trees the length of the project. Linn County plans to begin the design phase in 2022/23, with construction scheduled for 2024. A public meeting will be held when Linn County reaches the 30% design benchmark to allow for discussion and input from residents and City staff.

Pedestrian & Bicycle Improvement Project Updates

In support of their pending regional bicycle and pedestrian plan, the Albany Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (AAMPO) recently surveyed residents and property owners in Jefferson, Albany, Millersburg, and Tangent to discern priorities for bicycles and pedestrians infrastructure projects. Tangent had the second most respondents out of all four cities participating, and Tangent Drive pedestrian and bicycle improvements came in as the highest priority among potential projects in the city limits.

Also popular among Tangent respondents was a multi-use path along McFarland Road, crossing Highway 34 and extending along Looney Lane to the Linn Benton Community College campus. Information about AAMPO's bike/ped plan may be found at:
