Notice of Budget Committee Meeting

A public meeting of the Budget Committee of the City of Tangent, Linn County, State of Oregon, to discuss the budget for the fiscal year July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023, will be held at Tangent City Hall, 32166 Old Oak Drive, Tangent, OR. The meeting will take place on May 2, 2022 at 7:00 pm. The purpose of the meeting is to receive the budget message and to receive comment from the public on the budget. This is a public meeting where deliberation of the Budget Committee will take place. Any person may appear at the meeting and discuss the proposed programs with the Budget Committee. A copy of the budget document may be inspected or obtained on or after April 2, 2022 at Tangent City Hall between the hours of 9:00 am and 4:00 pm.

FREE Nitrate Testing of Well Water

Oregon State University Extension Service in conjunction with the City of Tangent is once again offering free well water testing for nitrates.

When: June 28, 2022 at 2:30-6:30 PM **Save the Date!**

Where: Tangent City Hall, 32166 Old Oak Drive

What to Bring: 1/2 cup of untreated well water

Testing only takes 10 minutes!

Why: Nitrate has been associated with a type of blue-baby syndrome, and there are other emerging concerns about other potential health problem associated with nitrate in drinking water. An educator will be on-site to answer questions about domestic wells and septic systems.

Keep a Green Space to Avoid Wildfires

It is approaching that time of year when high grass can turn into a problem with grass fires. Please make sure you comply with the following:

Except for commercially cultivated agricultural crops, between May 1 and September 30 of each year, the owner or occupant of property shall keep cut and remove from the property they own or use all dead bushes, dead trees, stumps, dry brush, dry vegetation, ladder fuels and any other material that could cause, spread, or fuel fire. The owner or occupant of property shall cut and maintain the grass and vegetation on the property they own or use at a maximum height of 10 inches between May 1 and September 30 each year. Failure to comply with these requirements shall be deemed to be a nuisance and a fire hazard. Residents whose property abuts any ditches or sidewalks need to keep the area around or in them mowed, too. **Thank you!**
