The City of Tangent

Established on July 23, 1973, the City of Tangent is a home rule city with a population of 1,231 as of the 2020 U.S. Census.



The City is a Manager Form Government, with an appointed City Manager, an elected Mayor, and four elected City Council members.

We also have a volunteer Planning Commission and contracted the following positions:

- City Attorney
- City Code Compliance Officer
- City Engineer
- City Planner
- Public Works

The City operates on Franchise Fee Taxes, State Revenue Sharing, and our Public Septic Sewer System is an Enterprise Fund that is self-sustaining financially.

The City sees renewed interest in community events such as the Tangent Harvest Festival, Food Truck Day, and more events in the future, adding to our endless stories of success!

The Position

The Finance Director leads the City's finances to manage accounting, financial reporting, banking, utility billing, payroll, accounts payable, accounts receivable, cash receipting, collections, debt service, permit payments, and other financial functions.



The position will manage the City's annual budget of approximately \$5,000,000 and participate in City Council and

Budget meetings.

In addition, the Finance Director will also:

- Prepare monthly and annual fiscal reports.
- Oversee the annual audit for the City.
- Develop and maintain internal controls.
- Maintain City lien records.
- Responsible for cash management.
- Inform City Manager to transfer funds between City accounts.
- Oversee compliance with grants.
- Develop finance-related ordinances and resolutions.
- Apply Generally Accepted Accounting Principals.
- Fill in for City Manager at meetings when needed.

Candidates must have or be able to obtain a valid Oregon Driver's License and work independently, with little or no supervision.

You may schedule a 10 to 15-minute call to ask questions to the Finance Director before August 19, 2022. Questions are to be focused on the roles and responsibilities of the position, workplace, and additional questions to understand the work at hand. We will not answer questions on other applicants or advise on submitting materials for the position's recruitment.

Hiring Process

City staff will evaluate applications and determine which one meets the minimum qualifications to advance to the interview round. Candidates will be notified and invited to interview, potentially two rounds of interviews. The selection committee will conduct interviews. Once a candidate is selected, a conditional offer of employment, pending a background check and additional steps if needed. The City Council will appoint the selected candidate that has accepted the offer and met all the conditions at a City Council meeting in September or October.
