2022 Accomplishments and Projects

The year 2022 saw the City of Tangent succeed in its goals of bringing back community events after the COVID19 Pandemic. The Summertime Social on August 2 saw over 150 people come to Bass Estate Park at City Hall to enjoy food, shaved ice, and meet with business vendors.

The City of Tangent and nine other cities launched Rural Economic Alliance (REAL), an Economic Development group dedicated to serving businesses. The City of Tangent is working with Albany Transit Systems to have a bus stop closer to the city's center. The City Council approved this work as part of the 2022 goals in January.

The January 2023 City Council meeting is scheduled for January 9, 2023, at 6:30 PM. All City Council meetings are held on the second Monday of each month.

The newly elected Councilmembers and re-elected Mayor will be sworn in office, and the city will approve 2023 goals.

Council goals are recommended and approved by the Council with a majority vote.
