New Business 1. Brush Trail Repairs – Discussion – Motion

The Brush Trail between Birdfoot and Tangent Dr. has seen more cracks appear on the trail. The City Council back in February asked for a review of the option for a temporary rather than a permanent fix. The three options were to seal cracks as they appeared, temporarily fix an upper pavement layer, and redo the entire trail with a deeper bedrock layer.

The cost of the temporary fix would be \$10,600 as of now. This would be \$300 for mobilization and \$5,600 for cutting, removing, rebasing, and paving a 4-inch thick area (106 linear feet x 2 feet wide). Crack seal and seal coat the pathway in the north section for \$4,700. The fix would buy the City about three, maybe four more years before having to redo the trail.

This was the cost from Blackstone Construction, which did the original paving of the trail. Since the cost exceeds \$10,000, we must get quotes from other construction companies. At the same time, City Staff is concerned about the quality of work from the company that initially put the trail in.

The potential option to motion is to have the City Engineer solicit bids from construction companies with the temporary fix, move toward a permanent fix, or take no action.
